# First time entry Guidelines

Hello and welcome to Carlisle Gamers. We are happy to welcome you to our Gaming Club, but first there are some notices and rules to go through first.

# How it works

Carlisle Gamers is a tabletop gaming club house ran by volunteers to provide a space for likeminded people to play games and socialise. We are open from 4pm – 11pm Monday to Friday, 12pm – 12am on Saturdays and 12pm – 11pm on a Sunday. All are welcome; however, we ask that those aged 16 of under are accompanied by a guardian.

As a Non-profit organization, all the money generated through entry and sales go back into the club. As such we do charge entry after your first visit. Entry is £5 per time or a monthly membership can be purchased for £20 which allows unlimited entry, discounts in the shop and other perks.

While there are lots of cool things in here, a lot of it is stored by individual members and as such need permission to be used. If there is something you are interested in, please speak to a committee member and they will advise you if it's available to use.

## Safety

Safety is of upmost importance to us as we want to provide a space accessible to as many people as possible. There are three main rules we have in place to help keep people safe.

- **CCTV**: CCTV is used throughout the building.
- **Safe Space:** Any forms of discrimination will result in immediate dismissal from the club and the potential future banning of entry.
- Fees: If someone is found to have wantonly damaged or stolen equipment, they will be fined three times the value of that piece and may be reported to the authorities. This also goes for communal facilities such as toilets and radiators etc.

We appreciate accidents happen and, in those cases, allowances can be made, but wilful breaking of these rules will not be tolerated nor permitted.

#### Storage

You are welcome to store items at the club (within reason) under the following conditions.

- 1. Items are kept in a clean and tidy manor and are not hazardous.
- 2. Items left for an extended period of time (over 6 months with no contact or prior arrangement) become club property to dispose of how they wish.
- 3. You understand that Carlisle Gamers is not liable for any personal property used or left in the club.

Carlisle Gamers also reserves the right to destroy anything they believe to be hazardous to members i.e. punctured spray cans, dirty clothes etc.

# Dogs

We are a dog friendly club and as such there may be dogs on the premises at the time of your visit. If you have issues with dogs, please get in contact before and we can try to accommodate a time when

we do not think there will be any on site. Alternatively, if you would like to bring your pet dog, please get in contact before bringing them to make sure that its suitable. We sometimes have the Chairmans resident pet, Tala, who has issues with other animals, and we want to make sure that both animals and owners have a non-stressful time. You will be asked to sign a waiver for any animals you bring into the club and understand that they are your responsibility when here.

### Cleanliness

As a volunteer ran organisation, we ask that everyone who uses our facilities to be mindful of messes they make. We do not have any cleaning staff, so we ask that everyone do their bit by disposing of rubbish correctly, cleaning up spills and emptying full bins. If everyone chips in, it makes it pleasanter experience all around.

Similarly, we ask that everyone entering have a good standard of personal hygiene. We have deodorant available for those hot and sweaty days but for those with poor hygiene, you may be discreetly asked to leave and return once you have had a shower.
